



Make your own Ranger load box dividers and create multiple storage zones




By using Ranger's tailgate as a workbench and using the two






forward of Plank A you can turn your Ranger's load box into a multi-purpose storage space. Make sure you place Plank A in on its long side (90mm) so that it sits securely in the slot.

Combine Side Panel A, Plank B & Plank A: From storing items securely

against the tailgate and storage boxes between Plank B and A, and



Combine Side Panel A, Plank B & 2x Plank A: Create a storage platform and a lower storage zone for things like recovery boards on top and swags underneath, while maintaining a storage zone up

against the tailgate.
