

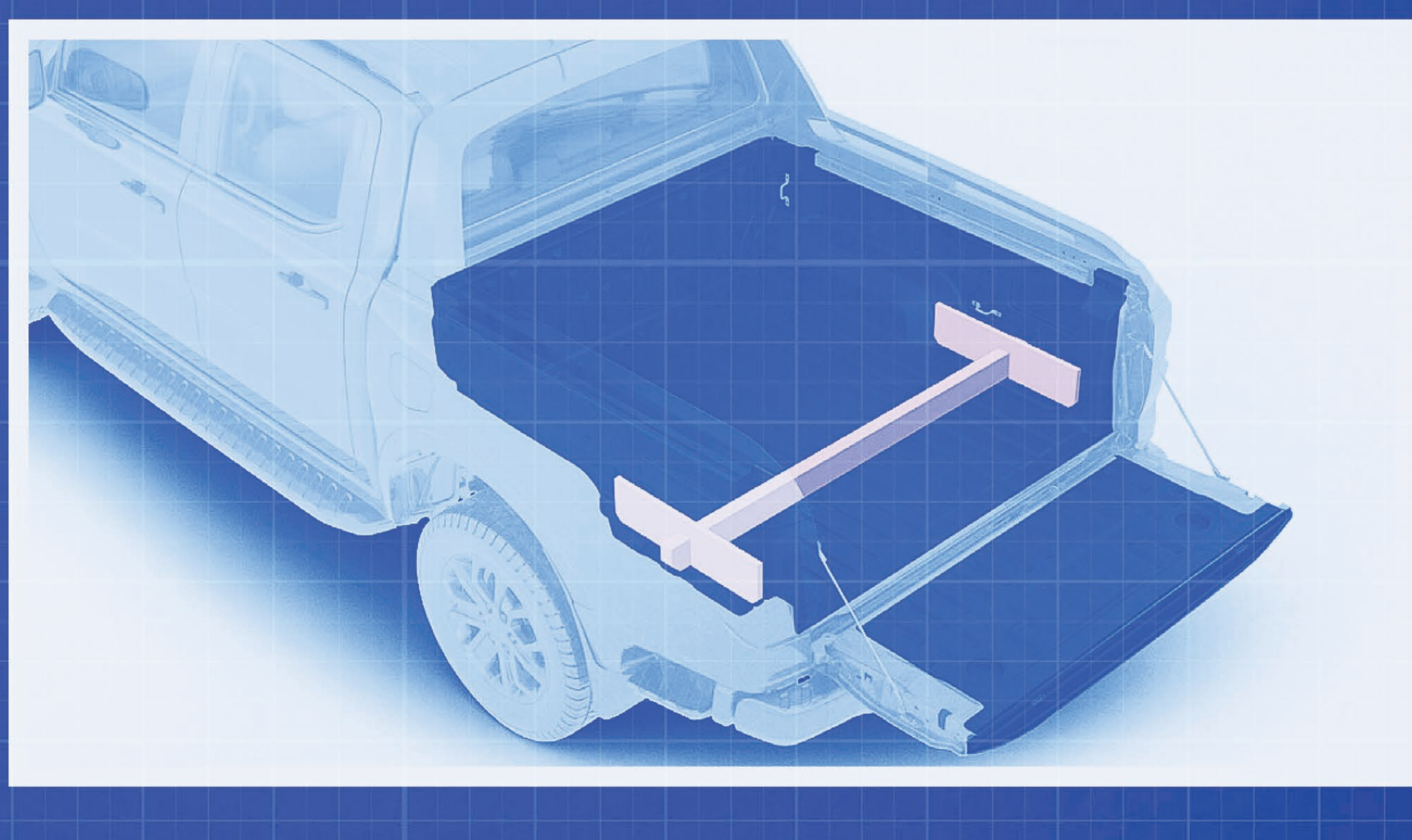
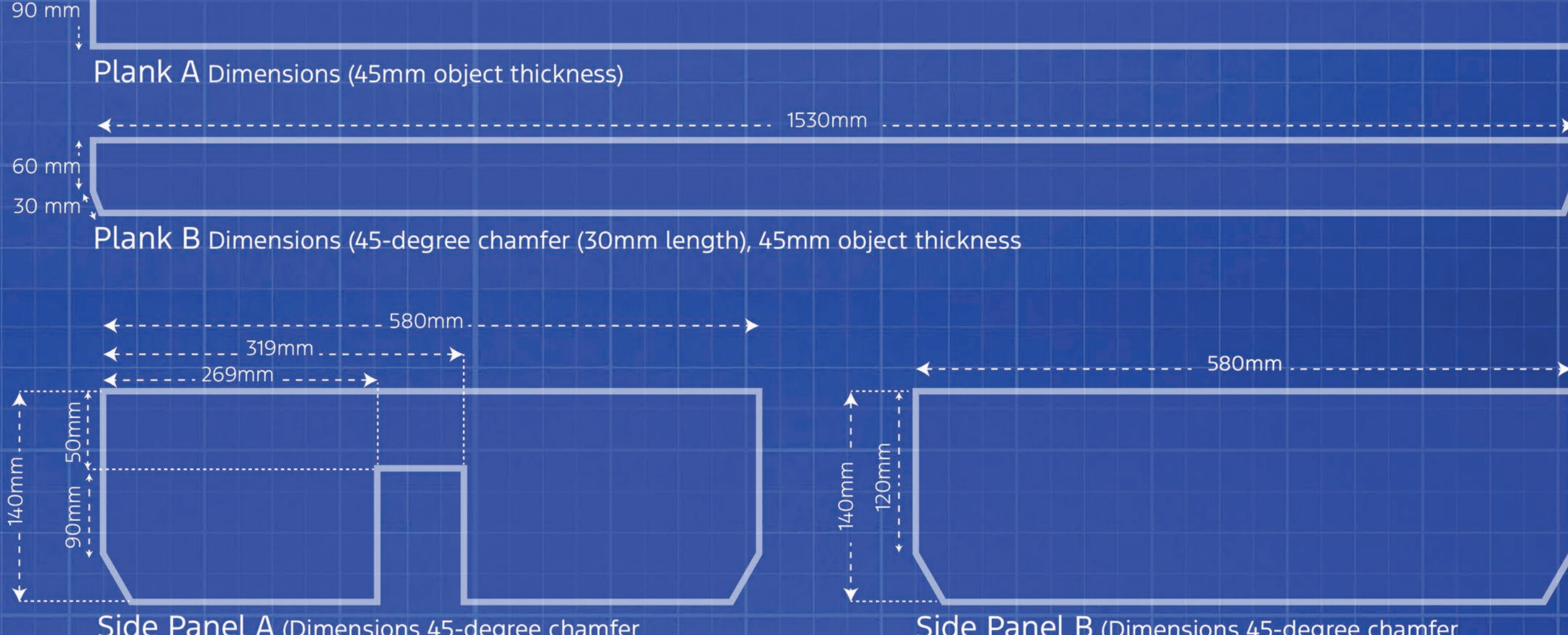


Make your own Ranger load box dividers and create multiple storage zones

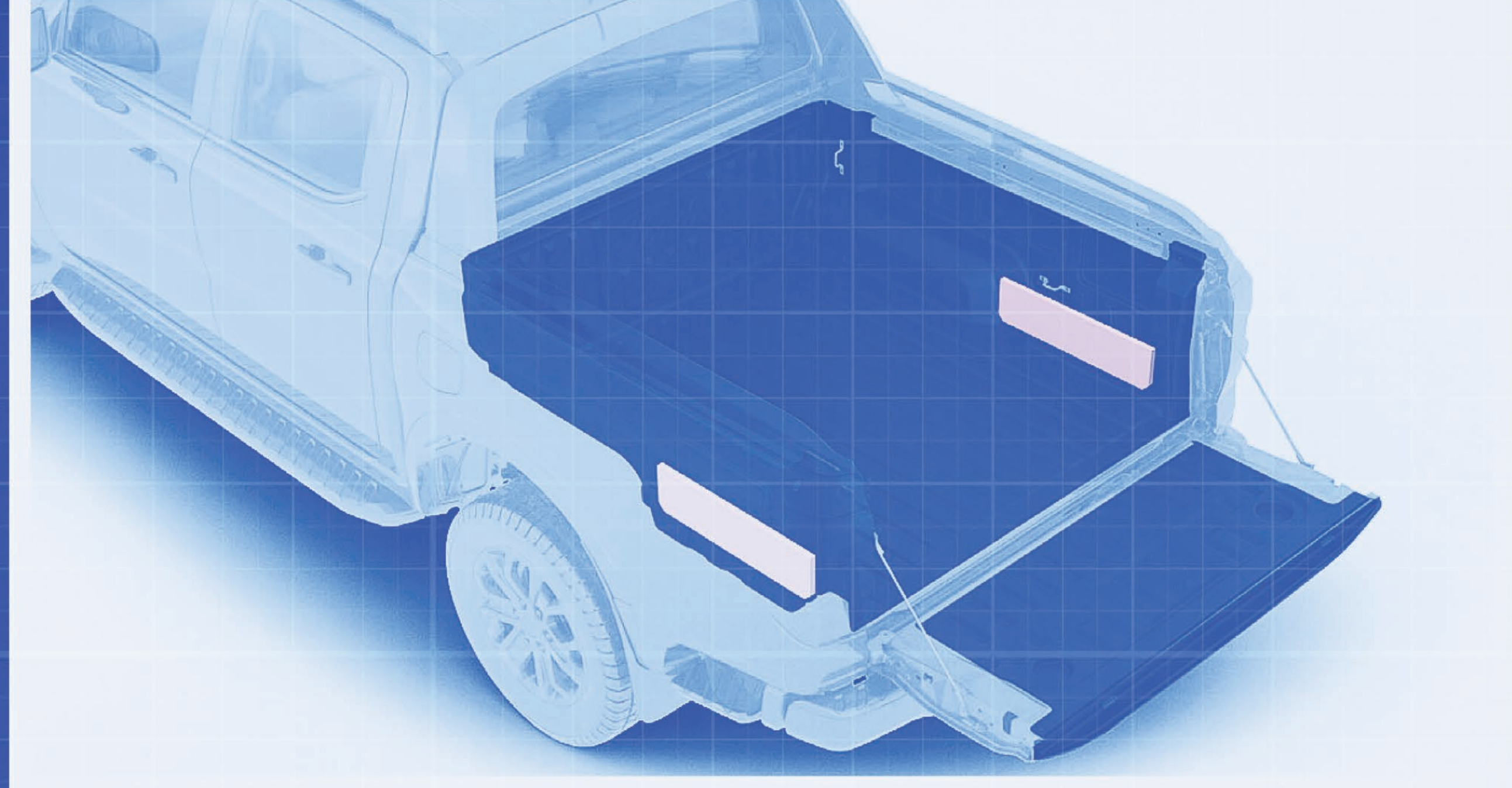
By using Ranger's tailgate as a workbench and using the two integrated clamp pockets, a tape measure, set square, pencil and a saw you can quickly and easily create partitions and turn your load box into a multi-zone, multi-purpose space.



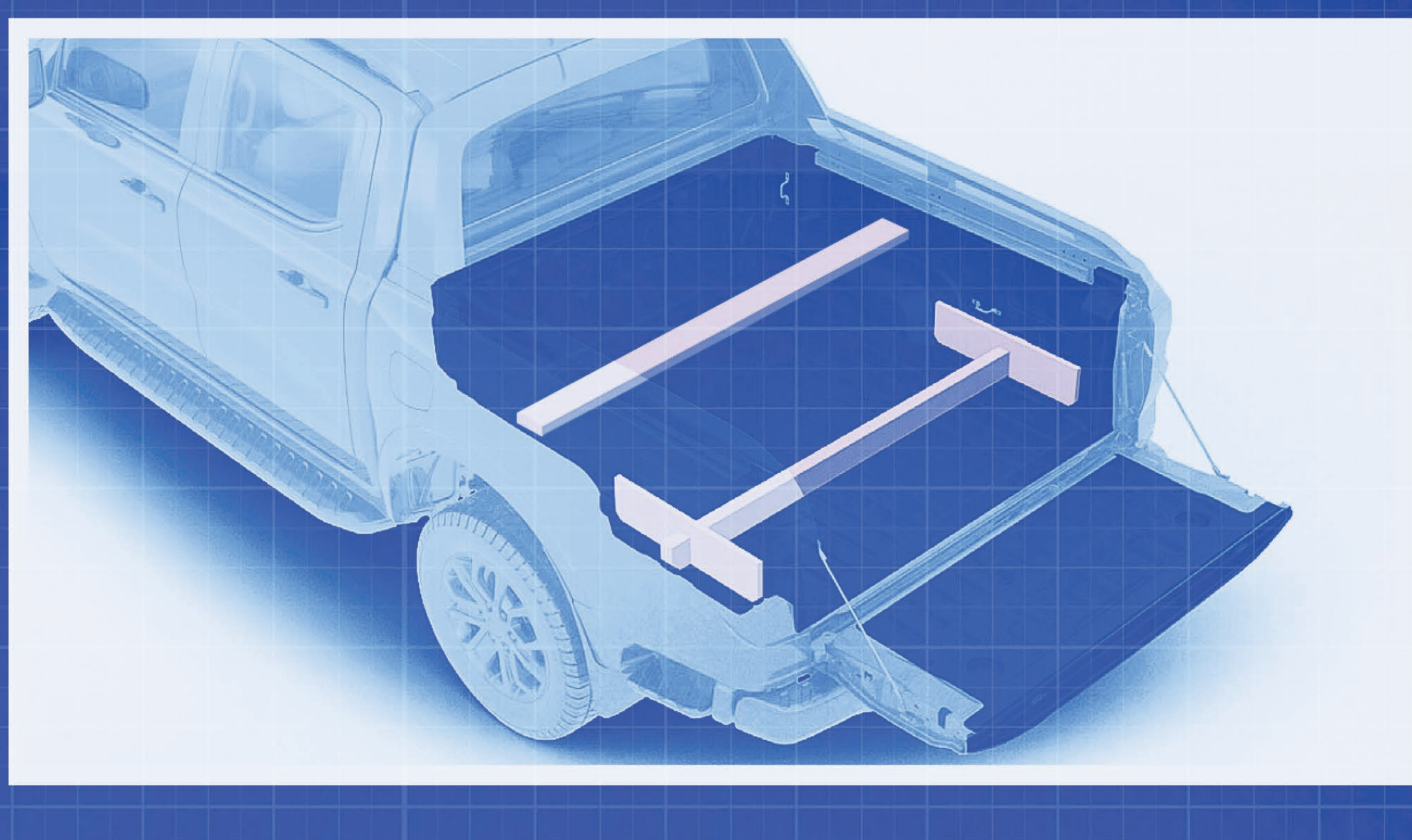
Dimensions



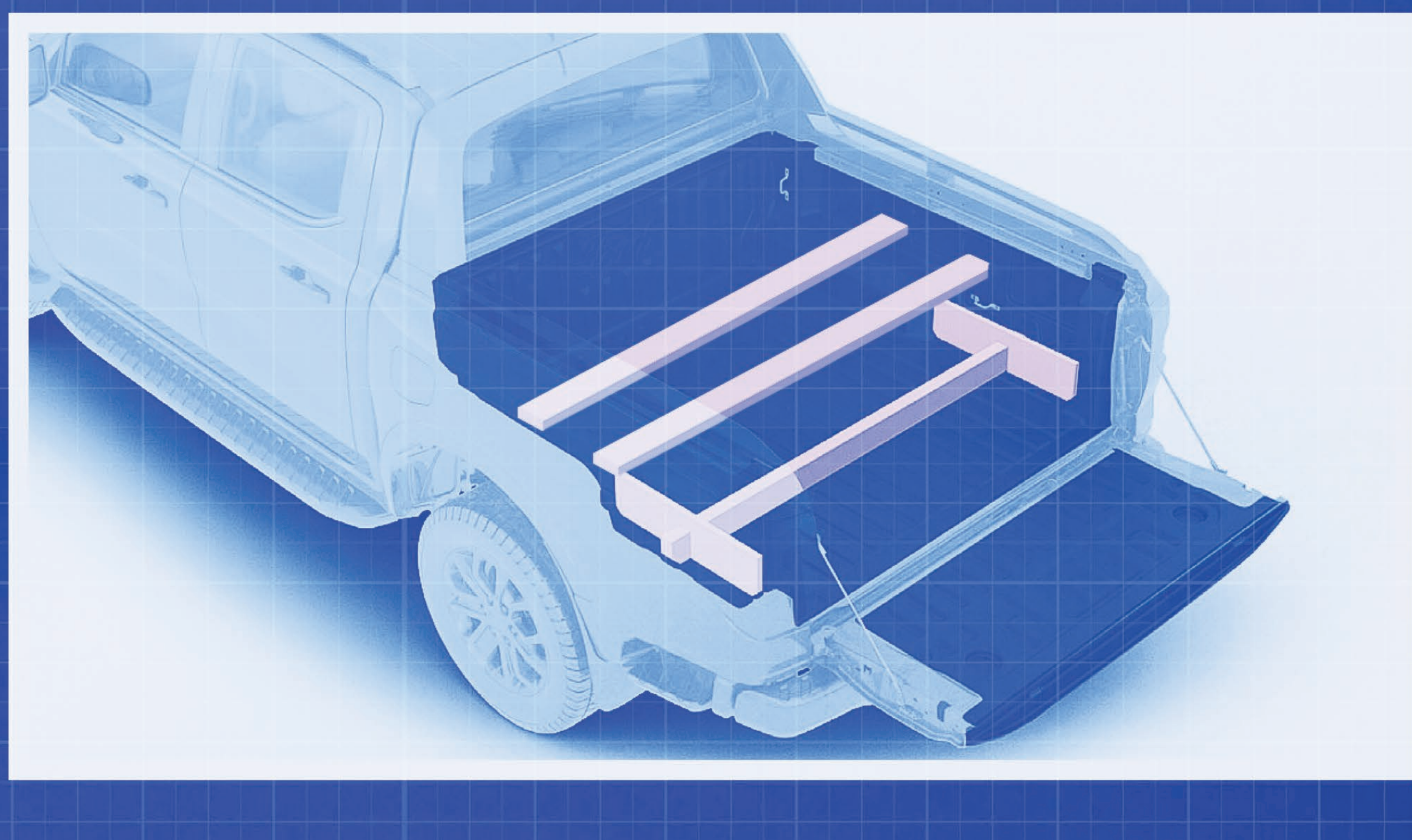
Side Panel A and Blank B: Use these two side panels in conjunction with Plank B to secure storage boxes, luggage or even groceries against the tailgate for easy access.



Side Panel B: Perfect for keeping tie-down ratchet straps, ropes, gloves, or recovery gear, create small storage spaces behind the wheel arches on one or both sides of the load box.



Combine Side Panel A, Plank B & Plank A: From storing items securely against the tailgate and storage boxes between Plank B and A, and forward of Plank A you can turn your Ranger's load box into a multi-purpose storage space. Make sure you place Plank A in on its long side (90mm) so that it sits securely in the slot.



Combine Side Panel A, Plank B & 2x Plank A: Create a storage platform and a lower storage zone for things like recovery boards on top and swags underneath, while maintaining a storage zone up against the tailgate.
